



COMAL COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICE DISTRICT NO. 7 PUBLIC NOTICE

The Board of Comal County Emergency Service District No. 7 will hold a meeting on April 30, 2026, at 8:30 AM at 550 Landa Drive, New Braunfels City Hall. The meeting is open to the public.

1. **Call to order.**

4. **Citizen Comment (Any individual may make a presentation relevant to the business of the district not more than three (3) minutes to the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners, after executing the proper form, which may be obtained from the Secretary).**

6. **Receive monthly report from the Fire Chief regarding emergency operations related to fire suppression and EMS response times, call volume, personnel staffing and training, management activities, communications, and public information activities.**
7. **Receive report from Treasurer and consider taking action, including the monthly financial report, and taking action on the payment of bills.**
8. **Review Budget – YTD 1st quarter.**
9. **Conduct an annual review of investment policy and investment strategies and adopt a resolution.**
10. **Review and approve the quarterly investment report for the 1st quarter of 2026.**
11. **Discuss and consider taking action regarding Strategic Planning.**
12. **Next meeting (agenda items and/or new/old business).**
13. **Adjournment.**

NOTICE

The District reserves the right to consider and take action on the above agenda items in any order. The Board may retire to Executive Session any time between the meeting's opening and adjournment for any purpose authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, including but not limited to: consultation with legal counsel (Section 551.071 of the Texas Government Code); personnel matters (Section 551.074) and/or discussion of real estate acquisition (Section 551.072). Action, if any, will be taken in open session.

A Citizens Comment Form must be filed with the Secretary at least 10 minutes prior to the beginning of the meeting for an individual to be allowed to speak during Citizen Comment. By completing the Citizen Comment Form, the individual understands and acknowledges that the public is not entitled to choose the items to be discussed or to speak about items on the agenda, but that this opportunity is provided as a privilege. The individual executing the Citizen Comment Form understands that he/she is provided a limited amount of time, and that he/she may not be allowed to continue to address the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners if the comments are rude, disparaging or defamatory to any individual or entity, or the comments become disruptive to the good order of the meeting. If at a meeting of a governmental body, a member of the public or of the governmental body inquires about a subject for which notice has not been given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, the notice provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act do not apply to a statement of specific factual information given in response to the inquiry; a recitation of existing policy in response to the inquiry; or, any deliberation of or decision about the subject of the inquiry shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a subsequent meeting.
